IN RE: REGISTRATION OF BS IV VEHICLES

We have heard Mr. K.V. Vishwanathan, learned senior counsel,

at length on the issue of the sale by Members as well as Non-Members, which have taken place during the lockdown period. In the affidavit filed by the Federation of Automobile Dealers Associations on 07.07.2020, for members and non-members figures have been given, the table is as follows:-

When we heard the matter on 27.03.2020, it is apparent that it was stated before us by the learned senior counsel that due to lockdown they were losing six days and in which they would not be able to sell the vehicles and figures of the sold as well as unsold vehicles were given. The sole consideration for allowing the sale after 31.03.2020 was lockdown. Order dated 27.03.2020 is extracted hereunder-

"IA Nos. 45883/2020, 45912/2020 & 48113/2020

is stated by Mr. K.V. Vishwanathan, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of applicant/Federation of Automobile Dealers Association that 1,05,000 two-wheelers, 2250 passenger cars and 2000 commercial vehicles are there which have been sold but not registered through out India. Unsold vehicles are stated to 7,00,000 two wheelers, 15,000 passenger cars be

and 12,000 commercial vehicles.

With the consent of Mr. A.N.S. Nadkarni, learned Additional Solicitor General and Mr. K.V. Vishwanathan, learned senior counsel, it is ordered that sold vehicles be registered by the concerned authorities by 30.04.2020. However, at the same time we direct the applicant to furnish details of the purchasers, on affidavit, of the aforesaid vehicles through e-mail, within seven days from today. Details of registration shall also be furnished to this Court.

With respect to unsold vehicles as the manufacturer should have been ready because of deadline set for BS-VI compliant vehicles, there is no justification to extend the time which was fixed long time ago. This is not something new which has occurred, it would be further injurious and further burden on human health to be caused by pollution of BS-IV vehicles when BS-VI vehicles are supposed to be produced by the manufacturers well in advance considering the deadline of 31st March, 2020.

It is stated that there are 7,00,000 two-wheelers which are unsold through out India with different dealers. Similarly, passenger vehicles are 15,000 and commercial vehicles are 12,000. In Delhi and NCR region, we are not allowing sale and registration of these kind of vehicles any more.

However, in the remaining part of the country, due to the situation which has arisen due to lock-down, it is ordered that not beyond 10% of the vehicles, except with the Dealers in Delhi and NCR region, are permitted to be sold out of the aforesaid number of vehicles to make up the good of six days which were available before the lock-down has been ordered in the country. Details of the sale shall be furnished by the applicant and there shall be no violation of the order passed by this Court. Sales to be done within ten days of the lifting of the lock-down operating in the concerned cities and not beyond it and on an affidavit number of vehicles sold shall be stated by the applicant/Federation of Automobile Dealers Association and only those vehicles shall be permitted to be registered about which affidavit is filed. If out of the vehicles which are permitted to be sold some of them remain unsold then obviously there is no question of any further extension of time for sale of these kind of vehicles. **Particulars** shall be given affidavit with engine and chassis numbers by the applicant/Federation of Automobile Association of the sale of vehicles before the registration is made, within seven days of the sale.

The application for impleadment is allowed to the

extent of intervention and these applications are accordingly, disposed of."

It is apparent from the order that this Court was not inclined to extend the time as the time was fixed long ago for sale of BS-IV Vehicles till 31.03.2020 and the vehicles of BS-VI technology were supposed to be produced by the manufacturers in advance, considering the deadline of 31.03.2020. However, at the fag end when we declined the prayer, an appeal was made by the learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the Federation of Automobile Dealers Associations that since due to lockdown they would not be able to sell any vehicle as such some period be given after lockdown is over, the figures in the tables mentioned indicate more sale during the period of lockdown.

It passes comprehension, how sale of vehicles could have been taken place during the lockdown. It was stated that may be that online sales have taken place and it was also stated in the affidavit that distress sales had taken place. Be that as it may, since the transactions given in the tabular form indicate more sales as compared to the data of non-lockdown period, we have no hesitation in recalling the order allowing the vehicles to be sold for 10 days after the lockdown was over. In view of the fact that Members as well as Non-Members had sold more vehicles during lockdown period, we have no hesitation to recall the order dated 27.03.2020 to aforesaid extent as it was passed only on the consideration that during lockdown, they would not be able to sell any vehicle that was the sole consideration for this Court to pass

the order. Thus, the benefit of the order cannot be taken two ways by making more sales during the period of lockdown and grace period of ten days further after 31.03.2020. It would be in violation of spirit of this Court's order, the vehicles shall be treated to be with dealers as if they are not sold and consideration if any received shall be returned forthwith to the purchasers, no such vehicles sold after 31.03.2020 of BS-IV technology shall be registered.

Coming to the question of registration of vehicles sold up to 31.03.2020, we request Ms. Aishwarya Bhati, learned Additional Solicitor General of India, to make verification as per the list submitted as to which vehicles were actually put on the E-Vahan portal of the Government and the data from other States of which data was not uploaded on E-Vahan portal also to be ascertained and filed before this Court before the next date of hearing, only thereafter we will consider question of registration and not before that. We have to see whether these transactions during lockdown are genuine transactions or they have been back dated.

The order dated 27.03.2020 is recalled with respect to sale of vehicles after lockdown period.

In the order dated 05.08.2019, we have quoted the Minutes of the Meeting regarding environmental norms and on 07.09.2019 in reproduction of paragraph 6 at page 13 of the order there is an omission made due to clerical error in not quoting '300 mg/Nm³ to 450 mg/Nm³'. Paragraph 6 of the Minutes of Meeting is reproduced hereunder:-

"6. After detailed discussion, it was agreed in principle to revise the NOx norms from 300 mg/Nm³ to 450 mg/Nm³ for Thermal Power Plants installed between 01/01/2004 to 31/12/2016 and same will be presented for a final decision to Secretary MoEF & CC and Secretary MoP."

The order is corrected in terms of paragraph 6 of the Minutes of Meeting. The words be read as '300 mg/Nm 3 to 450 mg/Nm 3 for Thermal Power Plants' instead of '300 mg/Nm 3 for Thermal Power Plants'.

The application is, accordingly disposed of.
